


Research, commitment, collaboration: Dr Shtofel completes her internship at CEITEC BUT

From 22 March to 6 April 2025, Dr Olha **Shtofel**, Associate Professor at the Department of General Physics and Modelling of Physical Processes of Igor Sikorsky Kyiv Polytechnic Institute, was doing her research internship at the CEITEC (Central European Institute of Technology) Brno University of Technology (BUT) within the framework of a joint project under the ERASMUS+ programme. During her internship at CEITEC BUT, Dr Shtofel conducted experiments in electron paramagnetic resonance (EPR) on crystals of silicon carbide (SiC), using the unique FRASCAN spectrometer. Read more




UNICA to be at European Youth Event
