
#### IAT students win AI Labeling Sprint

#### **Kyiv Polytechnic initiative among top** picks of joint Ukrainian-Latvian R&D projects

The Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine, together with the Latvian Council of Science, recently have closed the call for joint Ukrainian-Latvian research and development projects for 2025-2026. Based on the outcomes of an independent expert evaluation, 11 best initiatives have been cherry-picked to receive funds from government-supported grant funding.
