

#### Article on brief forgiveness workbook intervention published in BMJ Public Health

On 13 March 2024, the article "International REACH forgiveness intervention: a multisite randomised controlled trial" co-authored by Prof **Hennadii Korzhov** from the Faculty of Sociology and Law at the Igor Sikorsky Kyiv Polytechnic Institute in collaboration with Maya B Mathur from the Department of Pediatrics at Stanford University, Richard G Cowden and Tyler J VanderWeele from Harvard University et al. was published in BMJ Public Health – the international, open access and peer-reviewed journal of public health. The objective of this study is to determine whether a brief self-directed forgiveness workbook intervention could alter forgiveness, depression symptoms, and anxiety symptoms. Read more
