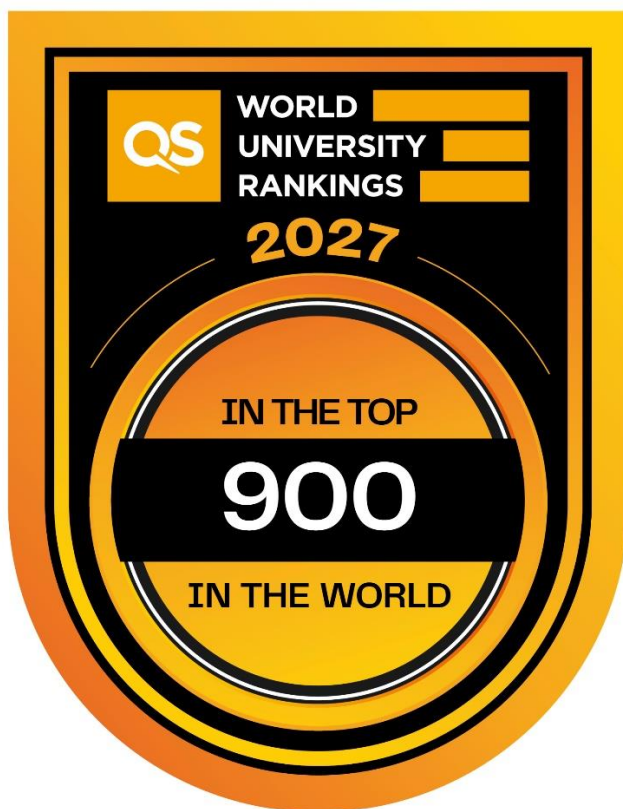
Czech partners contribute cutting-edge 3D scanning equipment

Kyiv Polytechnic shows notable advances in key QS WUR indicators

According to the 23rd edition of the QS World University Rankings (WUR), the Igor Sikorsky Kyiv Polytechnic Institute has been named as one of the world's top universities, ranking in the 851–900 band globally and sharing second place with the V.N. Karazin Kharkiv National University among leading higher education institutions in Ukraine. This year's ranking features 1,504 universities across 106 higher education systems, including nine in Ukraine. Of these, none climbs, five drop and four remain stable within their rank or band.
